How insurance works with BOMS

- Will my medical insurance cover the procedure? While we do not participate with medical insurance, if the tooth is impacted and you have out-of-network benefits, we are more than willing to submit the claim on your behalf for patient reimbursement as a courtesy (excluding Medicare). Please note that insurance plans vary, and there is no guarantee of coverage or benefits.
- What dental plans does BOMS take? We accept most major dental plans.
- Does BOMS accept Medicare? No, we are opt-out providers.
- If I have a billing question, who do I call? If you have any billing-related questions, please feel free to contact our office at 201-342-2371. We strive to provide clear and timely communication regarding any payments or concerns.
- When should I make my payment? Please be advised that all accounts are due and payable at the time of service, with payment options including cash, check, credit card (3% convenience fee applies), and participation with HSA. Additionally, financing options through CareCredit are available.

How do we communicate with our patients?

• To ensure effective and efficient communication with our patients, we utilize a state-of-the-art reminder system. Through this system, we can reach out to you via multiple channels, including text messages, phone calls, and emails. Preparing for Oral Surgery

- Can I eat or drink before my surgery? If you are scheduled to have intravenous sedation: You may not have anything to eat or drink for 6 hours before your appointment. Small sips of water are permitted for medications
